




Online Dating

Mairéad's Online Dating Rules


- 1.Don't use online dating as a filter to create Mr. Perfect. Everyone comes with their own story and personality. Don't get too fussy!
- 2. Give value in your messages.
- 3. Use online dating as a directory. It should only be used as a tool to meet people in person and go on real dates.
- 4.Do not share information or pictures that you would not be happy to share with a complete stranger in the street.
- 5. Always conduct yourself as a lady of high value.
- 6. Guys will always test the limits, respond playfully and do not do anything you do not feel 100% comfortable doing.
- 7.Don't make online dating your only method of dating, this is not being proactive.
- 8. As you are increasing the number of people you are connecting with, you are also increasing the number of times you will be rejected. This is normal. You will be rejected. Manage it as a lady of high value. "I am disappointed, I enjoyed speaking with you and I wish you the very best in your dating adventures. (Remember, we never try to reignite something with someone that has rejected us).

- 10. Most people are not good at writing profiles so don't eliminate people too quickly.

- 12. Google your number before sharing it with someone you are chatting to online- make sure it is not linked to your address or business.
- 13. Suggest and try and make sure in all cases you speak with the person on the phone before your date.
- 14. Stay safe, always tell someone where you are going and never go home or bring this person to your home on a first date.


